

LiteDisc Holder

The all-aluminum, telescopic accessory designed to hold and position the LiteDisc, MultiDisc* and a variety of other items such as foam core.

The following steps are covered in this instruction:

- · Placing the LiteDisc Holder onto a LiteStand
- Adjusting the LiteDisc Holder length
- Attaching a LiteDisc

Placing the LiteDisc Holder onto a LiteStand Figures 1-2

- Loosen T-knob at base of the LiteDisc Holder sufficiently to fit over the brass stud of the LiteStand.
- 2. Place LiteDisc Holder onto the brass stud of LiteStand and tighten the T-knob set screw to secure.

Adjusting the LiteDisc Holder Length Figures 3-4

- 3. Loosen the T-knob set screw on either clip to adjust the positioning on LiteDisc Holder.
- Slide the clip assembly to the desired position for your specific LiteDisc or MultiDisc and tighten the T-knob set screw to secure clip assembly in place.

NOTE: The LiteDisc Holder is also equipped with a length adjustment T-knob.

This T-knob is located between the clip assemblies and can be used to extend the LiteDisc Holder arm to accommodate larger LiteDiscs.

Attaching a LiteDisc to the LiteDisc Holder Figures 5-9

- To attach a LiteDisc apply pressure to the clip to open and allow you to insert the LiteDisc.
- 6. Release the clip to secure it to the edge of the LiteDisc.
- Repeat the process for the second clip located on the other side of the LiteDisc at the end of the holder arm.
- Be sure the length adjustment knob is set away from the LiteDisc. Here is an example of the knob correctly positioned away from the LiteDisc.
- Here is an example of the incorrectly positioned T-knob facing towards the Litedisc.

NOTE: Incorrect positioning of the knob will cause a bump in your reflection and can damage your LiteDisc fabric. Figure 10
